- **The Chapel Class: *The Present Word***

Through thematic study of biblical stories, class members are invited into a deepened relationship with God and a clearer

connection between life and faith. Study book available with daily devotionals connected to the lesson. (Chapel)

- **Passages: *Who Am I to You?***

Using Scripture and personal stories, we explore how our relationship with God guides and challenges our interaction with parents, children, spouses, siblings, friends, neighbors, coworkers and strangers. How do God's grace and Christ's example influence what we actually do and how might our relationships be different if we put Christ's teachings to work? Rotating topics and leaders. (S203)

- **Conversations: *Conversations About Love***

What does it mean to love our family members, those different from us, or our enemies as Jesus loved? This class focuses on this central but not-so-simple Biblical command as a way to balance the demands of our full schedules, advancing careers, aging parents, and active children. (P212)

- **Friends in Faith: *The Bible Project***

Bible tells one big story that is often lost in dissection of its contents. This class, which attracts those who are experiencing the opportunities and challenges of new careers and being parents of young children, discusses specific stories and their messages to us today while maintaining a connection to the larger story of the Old and New Testaments using a weekly timeline and video resource. - **Good Samaritan Class: *Faith and Culture***

Seeking direction, not answers, this class adapts its weekly topic based on current events frequently drawn from *The Christian Century* magazine. Topics include social, ethical, and theological matters impacting our lives today. All ages are welcome to join this conversation.
