Bible Study and Theology:

Chapel Class using *The Present Word* curriculum, this Scripture-based class studies the Covenants with God and how the early church proclaimed its faith in Christ. (Chapel)

Faith Foundations, a new class, welcomes those who are new to the church, new to the faith or simply want a refresher on the Bible, Presbyterianism, ministries of the church and ways to practice the faith. (P206)

Exploration of Faith and Real Life

The Good Samaritan Class discusses current events and looks to Scripture for guidance in making daily decisions. (Fresco Lobby)

Relationships with God, Neighbor and Self

A space for **Prayer** will be available for those who want silent time to pray for themselves or others. (P201)

A space for **Fellowship** is available to connect with others. (S202)

Bible Study, Real Life, Relationships

Passages presents topics that invite exploration of Scripture and ways of living the faith personally and for the world. Teaching and discussion are attentive to the needs and interests of those who are navigating mid-life passages, but the class is open to all. This group gathers for social events at least twice a year. (S203)

Conversations uses its round-table setting to explore ways we understand Scripture and apply it to our lives. Pastors, staff and class members guide conversations emphasizing the importance of life together in faith. (P212)



How much will we grow our skills at tennis or yoga or reading if all we do is watch a video or listen to someone else talk about their experiences? We won't get much better until we pick up a racket or open a book or practice Tree pose.
